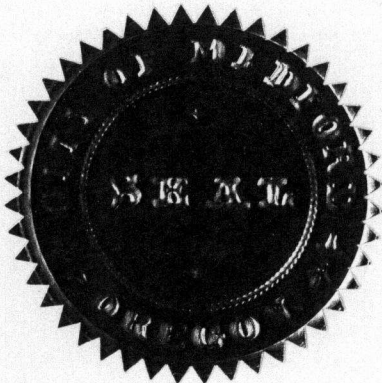
WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to Callie Marek for her outstanding service to Veterans in Oregon.
