WHEREAS, both men and women of our armed forces continue to be an inspiration to us all through the demonstration of courage, leadership and commitment in service to our community and country; and

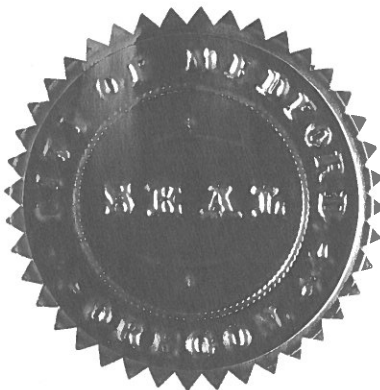
WHEREAS, in 1975, Congress voted to approve Veterans Day as a national holiday every November 11 in honor of all our Veterans, who have served in the armed forces; and
