WHEREAS, Sue Naumes has served our Rogue Valley community in many capacities for decades; and

WHEREAS, Sue Naumes, with her family, has volunteered at St. Vincent de Paul to help families and individuals in our valley who are in need of food and assistance, especially during the holiday seasons; and

WHEREAS, Sue Naumes has taken a successful leadership role with the Carpenter Foundation, the Oregon Community Foundation, the Walker Advisory Committee and the Joe and Frances Naumes Family Foundation; she has also served on the Medford Irrigation District Board, Rogue Basin Water Users Council Board, as well as significantly supported the Craterian Performing Arts Center and the Art in Bloom Festival; and
