What to Bring Daily

- Pack two snacks, a water bottle, and a lunch if your camper prefers not to participate in the free lunch program or if there is no lunch program available.
- Free Lunch Program at Jackson Elementary School: June 15-August 20. *(Dates subject to change)*
- Ensure campers wear appropriate clothing suitable for outdoor activities and walking to Jackson School.
- Tuesdays & Thursdays—Wear swimsuit under clothes & bring a towel for swimming (we do not provide towels or swimsuits)
- Electronics, toys, trading cards, and similar items are not permitted at camp and will be requested to be put away.

*The City of Medford is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items

Sign-in and Sign-out:

- Drop-off and pick-up for Day Camp will occur at the Santo Community Center unless otherwise specified in the parent weekly email.
- For drop-off and pick-up, you or another authorized adult **MUST** walk your camper in and sign them in with a camp staff member.
- Pick-up will occur at the front of the Santo Community Center. A staff member will be available at 5:15 PM for check-out.
- If you plan to pick up your child before the end of the camp day, please proceed to the front desk, and our staff will arrange for your child to be called from their designated group.
- **Pick up on Tues. and Thurs. After 1:45 PM, will be at Rogue X (901 Rossanley Dr.). Weekly emails will include specific details on pick up.**
- If staff need to contact a parent/guardian due to health or behavior concerns, they will call the first contact listed on the child's Perfect Mind account. If there is no answer, emergency contacts will be called in order as listed.

Camp Refund Policy: To receive a full refund, a written notification must be received at least 5 business days before the camp week.

- To receive a partial refund, a written notification must be received at least 3 business days before camp starts. (Wednesday before camp begins)
- There are no refunds for camp within the 48 hours before the week of the camp start date.
- A \$10 processing fee will be retained by MPRD for all refunds.

Absent from Camp: There is no credit for missed days. If your child had a communicable illness at camp (lice, strep, etc.), please email parks@cityofmedford.org to inform camp staff.

Parent/Staff Communication: A Parent information e-mail is sent on the Thursday before the week your child is registered for camp.

Payment Plan: Payment plans are available for in-house registration at the Santo Community Center.

Online Registration: Payment is due in full at the time of registration.

Late Fee Policy: A \$1 per minute late fee will be applied for pick-up past the five-minute grace period.

- After the 5-minute grace period, recreation staff will attempt to contact a parent or emergency contact person to pick up the child.

Rogue X: Swimming Tuesdays & Thursdays:

- All Campers will be swimming on Tuesdays & Thursdays.
- Pick up on Thursdays after 1:45Pm will be at Rogue X (901 Rossanley Dr.)
- Campers must pass a swim test to swim in the deep area of the pool and must be tall enough to use the large water slides.
- If a camper needs a lifejacket, indicate so on the questionnaire or notify camp directors.

Sunscreen Policy: Staff are ONLY permitted to administer sunscreen if the following criteria are met:

- Parents have authorized staff to apply sunscreen on the registration questionnaire.
- Sunscreen provided must be in spray form, labeled with the child's name.

Security Cameras: The City of Medford has security cameras placed throughout the public areas of the facility and grounds. These cameras are recording and viewing multiple locations. This system allows us to deter theft and review incidents that warrant law enforcement or internal investigations.

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
