## STATE GRANT HELPS RESTORE 22 MONUMENTS AT HISTORIC EASTWOOD CEMETERY

Twenty-two monuments at the historic Eastwood Cemetery were recently restored as part of ongoing preservation efforts for one of Medford's oldest burial grounds.


Chase Memorials relevelled and reglued aging marble and granite markers—some dating back to the late 1800s—to improve safety and appearance.

The \$8,650 project, supported by a \$4,325 grant from the Oregon Historic Cemeteries Program, brings the total number of restored headstones to more than 60 in recent years.


Founded in 1890 and acquired by the City in 1972, the cemetery is currently managed by the Medford Parks, Recreation and Facilities Department.
